

Third Online workshop on "NAAC Awareness" for Jammu Division Colleges at GDC Ramban


Group "C"


Colleges headed by their principals participated in this workshop:

This NAAC awareness Workshop was held



under the aegis patronage and expertise of Dr. (Moshin) Bashir Dar. The Principals from all the participating colleges, their IQAC coordinators and other IQAC members joined the workshop. The workshop started at 11: 00 am with the formal welcome addresses by Prof. Rajiv Kumar Co-cordinator IQAC GDC Ramban. In the inaugural session Prof. Ajaz Ahmad Cordinator IQAC GDC Ramban in his introductory speech talked about the importance of IQAC cells in the colleges. He also highlighted seven (7) criteria needed for submission of annual quality assurance report (AQAR). Dr. Mohsin Bashir Dar the NAAC expert and as resource person delivered a detailed lecture on the importance of quality education in J&K that could compete western standard of quality education. He emphasized on the implementation of NAAC for the quality education in the colleges. He explained the importance of IQAC cells in colleges, documentation of events, and preparation of SSRs and submission of AQARs. His enlightening lecture fulfilled



all the aspects of the workshop. In the middle of the session Respected Commissioner Secretary Higher Education Ms. Sushma Chuhan (IAS) also joined the meeting and in her brief presence she stressed upon the need of the accreditation of degree colleges and implementation of National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. For which she impressed upon all the stakeholders for the joint team

work. She also enquired about the quality of the workshop.

Later Dr. Ranjeent Singh Jamwal Principal SPMR Commerce College Jammu shared his valuable experience about the NAAC accreditation process and interacted with the participants. In his supportive talk he emphasized on the timely submission of annual quality assurance report (AQAR) and preparation of SSRs.

Then the workshop was kept open for interactive session with all the principals of participating colleges, their IQAC coordinators and other participants who interacted with the NAAC expert Dr. Bashir Dar. The Principals of newly established colleges highlighted their varied problems and demanded infrastructural development and requirement of staff especially the non-teaching staff for their respective colleges. Prof. Younis Ahmad Rather GDC Ramban acted as a technical coordinator and conducted all the proceedings of the workshop.
